

## **Additional information in regards to the project**

### **FAQ:**

1. *Will the participants get any daily allowances?* Not in terms of pocket money. The participants will get free interrail passes, free ISIC cards, free hostelling international membership cards (but they still need to cover their accommodation), free European train timetables
2. *How much money they need to bring with them?* Between 20-25 daily budget
3. *Will they receive certificate upon the completion of the project?*

4. *Could they participate if they are under 18 and have parent's permission.* Youth under 18 could be a problem for visas so this needs to be checked. In principle I would say no

5/6: *Where they will be accommodated?/Which towns will they visit and what are the planned destinations (which organizations...)* Inter Rail is a special rail pass for unlimited travel in 2nd class throughout Europe. The characteristic of the interrail pass is that is flexible and you can move freely trough Europe for one month on 2nd class trains. Interrail is NOT an organized trip. The only organized "stops" related to are Vienna on July 25th where we will organize a workshop and a stop in Rome Aug 1st. for the rest, the youth will choose by themselves their itinerary and which destinations they would like to reach. Concerning accommodation, usually youth traveling in interrail sleep in youth hostels (low price accommodations. in this regard, the youth will be provided with membership cards of the International Youth Hostels Federation that they will need to show in order to access the youth hostels affiliated to the federation -pls note that the membership cards do not cover the expenses for accommodation in the hostels-)

7. *If they have their high school diploma and plan to enroll the college are they eligible to apply and will they provide GPA from the last year of high school?* Yes they are. Yes they should.

8. *Could you specify the duration of this project considering the September's exams term?* The interrail ticket expires after one month. The youth will be leaving from their cities on 23/24 July so they can travel until 22 July. If the youth for their own reasons decide to use the ticket for less than one month and come back earlier, it is their choice. As I would like to reiterate, the interrail in itself is not an organized trip and leaves a lot of flexibility in terms of itinerary and timings.
